ADVISORY NOTE

The Government of India has started issuing CDC to candidates who are Xth Class passed, havaing valid Passport, medically fit and have completed the 5 Basic STCW Modular Courses (viz., PST, PSSR, EFA, FPFF & STSDSD). The Refresher Courses for PST and FPFF are to be undertaken every five years.

- 2. It has come to the notice of the Directorate that lot of candidates are facing problems as their Master Checker is showing Refresher Courses of PST and FPFF and not the Basic PST, FPFF Courses. This is causing error in the e-governance system due to which the candidates are not able to apply for CDC online. It has also come to the notice of the Directorate that some agents / touts are misguiding the candidates to undertake the two basic courses PST and FPFF again even though candidates have successfully completed these courses earlier. The Directorate hereby advises the candidates not to repeat the PST and FPFF Courses if their Refresher PST and Refresher FPFF are already uploaded in the Master Checker. Further, all the candidates are advised to wait till 15th of February, 2018 to review the online CDC application process. The candidates are also advised to be patient and stay away from agents.
- 3. This issues with the approval of the Director General of Shipping and Special Secretary to the Government of India.
